TRANSCRIPT LEGEND

HISTORY:

Wallace State was originally named George C. Wallace State Trade School of Cullman County and was a creation of the state legislature by Act No. 93, approved May 3, 1963. The institution began classes on August 1, 1966, and was granted full accreditation in 1978 by the Commission on Colleges. The Honorable George C. Wallace, Governor of Alabama, dedicated the original buildings on September 11, 1966.

ACCREDITATION:

Wallace State Community College is fully accredited by the Alabama Department of Education and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

UNIT OF CREDIT:

Wallace State Community College converted to the semester credit hour system effective fall 1998. Prior to this date the college operated on the quarter credit hour system.

ACADEMIC TERM:

Wallace State Community College normally has the following terms each academic year:

Fall Term	(16 weeks) beginning in August
Spring Term	(16 weeks) beginning in January
Summer Term	(10 weeks) beginning in May

ACADEMIC STANDING:

A student is in good standing and is academically eligible to re-enroll unless otherwise noted on the transcript.

TRANSFER CREDIT:

Courses and hours accepted from other institutions will be reflected on the Wallace State Community College transcripts.

COURSE FORGIVENESS:

If a student repeats a course once, the last grade awarded (excluding a grade of "W") replaces the first grade in the computation of the cumulative grade point average. The semester grade point average during the semester in which the course was first attempted and thereafter will be affected. The official transcript will list the course and grade each time it is attempted.

When a course is repeated more than once, all grades for the course excluding the first grade will be employed in computation of the cumulative grade point average. Official records at the institution will list each course in which a student has enrolled. Students are responsible for reviewing their transcripts at the end of each semester. Discrepancies should be brought to the attention of the College Registrar by completing a request for Course Forgiveness form.

OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS:

An official transcript is printed on secure paper, does not require a raised seal, and is valid only when it bears the signature of the registrar. Copies issued to students will have "Official Transcript Issued to Student" stamped on the transcript. All official transcripts dated before summer 1989 will be black and white and will have the official seal of Wallace State Community College and signature of registrar.
